G20 Research Conclave for Faculty and Researchers On Knowledge Exchange in a Globalized World (31st Aug - 1st Sep 2023)

Concept Note

Overview:

The Research and Consultancy Division instituted Shodhotsav, AUD's Research Festival in 2020 to bring together faculty and researchers from within and outside the institution to exchange ideas on knowledge production and practices. This is the third in the series of the event which is being planned in August and September. We propose a national conference (**G20 Research Conclave**) for faculty and researchers across the universities spread across two days from 31st August (Thursday) to 1st September 2023 (Friday). The venue for both days is Karampura Campus, Dr. B. R Ambedkar University Delhi.

First day will be devoted to organising paper presentations on the working papers/research that have been funded through Seed Money Grants for Faculty Research (SMGFR) disbursed in the last two years through the Research and Consultancy Division of the University and other projects sponsored by agencies including ICSSR and UGC. On the second day, we plan to give an open call to all interested faculty members and researchers to showcase their present or upcoming projects/ papers/ books that may be in the pipeline or are published under the following suggested broad themes:

- 1. Pedagogical Reflections in Teaching and Practice
- 2. Policy Development Exercises and Engagement with Social Sciences and Humanities
- 3. Newer Research Horizons in Social Sciences and Humanities

Objectives:

- 1. To initiate and encourage faculty and researchers for knowledge exchange among themselves aimed at peer learning and adoption of best practices
- 2. To engage with the current debates on different pedagogical practices and experiments done within various disciplines and practitioners
- 3. To reflect on symbiotic relationship between policy matters/development and data sets emerging from wide ranging perspectives of social sciences
- 4. To explore the interdisciplinary and interactive dynamic of research in India in the global context

Expected Outcomes:

- 1. Nuanced exchange of ideas, methods and professional practices with regard to recent trends of research in social sciences
- 2. Robust understanding of the socio-cultural context in policy engagements
- 3. Peer reflection and exchange of ideas on a wide range of pedagogical practices within various disciplines
- 4. Exploration of the social science research dynamic in the global world
- 5. Possibilities of consultation with CFP-AUD and other journals shall also be explored to publish the seminar proceedings

Target Audience:

The conference is open to all the faculty and researchers of colleges and universities across the country and will be dedicated to a discussion on the research endeavours undertaken in different type of financial and institutional contexts (Seed money Grant for Faculty Research, ICSSR, UGC), book publications as well as independent researches done by the faculty and researchers (also visiting, affiliated).

Call for Abstracts:

Abstracts for the Seminar are invited by the interested faculty and researchers who wish to engage with the various themes of the seminar. The word limit for the abstracts shall be 250 words. The abstracts will be received only through the google form link shared below. The faculty and researchers shall be informed about their respective schedule and acceptance by the conference committee by 16 July 2023.

The selected participants must submit their completed papers by 25th July 2023 through the online submission form that will be circulated with the email confirming the acceptance of the abstract. The world limit for the papers is 5000 to 6000 words (excluding references).
