Election Release IV: Councillors' Debate

3rd October 2018

As per Article 6.2, d) of the Ambedkar University Delhi Constitution of the Students' Union, "participation in the Councillors' Debate is a pre-condition for contesting in elections" failing which candidacy is liable to be disqualified. The Councillors' Debate is an opportunity for candidates to present their manifesto to their respective constituency.

Debate between the candidates shall take place in presence of majority members of the constituency. In case the candidate for a particular constituency stands unopposed, the candidate is required to present her/his manifesto to the respective constituency, with majority strength during the scheduled debate.

The debate, as per the Election Schedule, is organised on 8th October' 2018 (Monday). Candidates who have filed nominations for the post of Councillors are instructed to coordinate with their respective programme coordinators and schedule a time and venue for their debates. Time and venue of debate has to be notified to the CECC e-mail ID (cecc2018@aud.ac.in) before 8th of October. Furthermore, the candidates are instructed to email the minutes of the debate to CECC, latest by midnight of 8th October, 2018.
