SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. BASIS FOR PREPARATION OF ACCOUNTS

The accounts are prepared under the Historical Cost Convention unless otherwise stated and generally on the Accrual method of accounting. Provisions have made as far as possible for all known assets, liabilities, expenses, income and known losses but personal claims like medical claims, child education allowance, LTC etc. have been accounted for on receipt basis.

2. REVENUE RECOGNITION

- a. Fees from Students collected separately for each semester has been accounted for on accrual basis and admission fee & interest on savings bank account are accounted on cash basis.
- b. Interest on Investments is accounted for on accrual basis.

3. FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

- a. Fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition including inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition, installation and commissioning.
- b. Fixed assets are valued at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation on fixed assets is provided on Straight line method, at the following rates:

- c. Depreciation is provided for the whole year on the additions during the year.
- d. Assets acquired from project is not taken into fixed asset of AUD, the same will be taken into AUD stock after the completion of project and on physically handing over to GIA. This will however be subject to Project terms and conditions.

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- e. Where an asset is fully depreciated, it will be carried at a residual value of Re 1 in the Balance Sheet and will not be further depreciated. Therefore, depreciation is calculated on the additions during the year separately at the application rate of depreciation.
- f. Where the individual value of the assets purchased is less than Rs. 2000/- (except Library Books) are treated as Small Value Assets and 100% depreciation is provided in respect of such assets at the time of their acquisition. However physical accounting and control are continued by the holders of such assets.
- g. According to Accounting Standard 10 Property Plant and Equipment, Land Leasehold (Perpetual lease) has been valued on Purchase Value and Depreciation on Land is to be charged at 0%.
- 4. INTANGIBLE ASSETS: Computer Software and E-Journals are grouped under Intangible Assets.

5. STOCKS

Expenditure on purchase of chemicals, glassware, publications and other stores is accounted as revenue expenditure. Except that the value of closing stocks held on 31st March is set up as inventories by reducing the corresponding Revenue Expenditure on the basis of information obtained from Departments. They are valued at cost.

6. RETIREMENT BENEFITS

Provision for Gratuity and Leave Encashment are provided on basis of Actuarial valuation. Capitalized Value of pension and gratuity received from previous employers of the Institution's employees, who have been absorbed in the Institution, is credited to the respective Provision Accounts. Pension contribution received in respect of employees on deputation is also credited to the Provision for Pension Account. The Actual payments of Pension, Gratuity and Leave encashment are debited in the Accounts to the respective provisions. Other retirement benefits viz. Deposit Linked Insurance, Contribution to New Pension Scheme, Medical reimbursement to retired employees and Travel to Home Town on retirement are accounted on accrual basis (actual payments plus outstanding bills at the end of the year).

7. INVESTMENTS

- a. Long term investments are carried at their cost or face value whichever is lower. However, any permanent diminution in their value as on the date of the Balance Sheet is provided for.
- b. Short Term investments are carried at their cost or market value (if quoted) whichever is lower.

8. EARMARKED/ENDOWNMENT FUNDS

The following long term funds are earmarked for specific purposes.

- i. Scholarship
- ii. Learning Enhancement
- iii. Student Welfare Fund
- iv. Application Fee

Separate bank accounts have been maintained for above funds and interest on savings bank account is

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credited to the respective funds. The expenditure and advances (in the case of House Building & Conveyance/Computer) are debited to the fund. The balance in the respective funds is carried forward and is represented on the assets side by the balance at Bank, Investments and Accrued Interest.

Endowment Funds

The following Endowment Funds are created under UDF in Ambedkar University Delhi

- i. Student Travel and Exchange Programme Fund
- ii. Academic Chairs Fund
- iii. Research Endowment Fund
- iv. Central Pool of UDF

While each of the Endowment funds has its own investment there is one savings Bank Account each for all the Endowment funds, as the un invested balances against them are negligible

The income from investment of each Endowment Fund is added to the Fund. The interest on Savings Bank Account is also added to each Endowment fund. The expenditure is met from the interest earned on investment of the respective Endowment funds and the balance is carried forward.

The balances are represented by Investment in Fixed Deposits and balance in the Saving Bank Account common for all Endowments, and Accrued Interest on Investments.

9. GOVERNMENT AND UGC GRANTS

Government Grants and UGC grants are accounted for on realization basis. However, where a sanction for release of grant pertaining to the financial year is received before 31st March and the grant is actually received in the next financial year, the grant is accounted on accrual basis and an equal amount is shown as Amount in Transit.

10. SPONSORED PROJECTS

- a. In respect of ongoing Sponsored Projects, the amounts received from sponsors are credited to the head "Current Liabilities and Provisions -Current Liabilities -Other Liabilities -Receipts against ongoing sponsored projects." As and when expenditure is incurred /advances are paid against such projects, or the concerned project account is debited with allocated overhead charges, the liability account is debited.
- b. In addition to the Earmarked Fund for the Junior Research Fellowships funded by the University Grants Commission, Fellowships and Scholarships are also sponsored by various organizations. These are accounted in the same way as Sponsored Projects except that the expenditure generally is only on disbursement of Fellowships and Scholarships, which may include allowances for contingent expenditure by the Fellows and scholars.
- c. The Institution itself also awards Fellowships and Scholarships, which are accounted as Academic expenses.

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11. INCOME TAX

The income of the University is exempt from Income Tax under section 10(23C) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, hence no provision is therefore made in the accounts.

NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

1. FIXED ASSETS:

- a. Additions in the year to fixed assets in Schedule 4 include assets purchased out of Grant in Aid.
- b. Depreciation amounting to Rs 6,21,28,829/- has been charged during the financial year.
- c. Fixed assets as set out in Schedule 4 do not include assets purchased out of funds of sponsored projects, held and used by the Institution, as project contracts include stipulations that all such assets purchased out of projects funds will remain the property of the sponsors.
- d. Land of ₹142.92 crore shown in the Fixed Assets is on perpetual lease allotted by Delhi Development Authority to Directorate of Higher Education, GNCTD at Dheerpur for setting up of Campuses by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University. As such the land has been shown as Land -Leasehold under Fixed Assets. Ground rent payment of Rs. 3.42 crore was capitalized in the value of land in previous financial year. However, this amount has been transferred to Prior Period Expenses during the current financial year.
- e. Depreciation for the financial year 2019-20 & 2020-21 charged on capital assets amounting to Rs. 2,23,435/- has been transferred to Prior Period Expenses during the current financial year.
- f. Preliminary Expenses of Dheerpur Campus amounted Rs. 9,33,144/- was booked under WIP during the previous financial year, being revenue in nature have been transferred to Prior Period Expenses during the current financial year.
- g. Preliminary Expenses of Kashmere Gate amounted Rs. 33,336/- was booked under WIP during the previous financial year, which were revenue in nature has been transferred to Prior Period Expenses during the current financial year.
- h. Preliminary Expenses of Dheerpur Campus and Rohini Campus amounted Rs. 1,06,95,840/- and Rs. 1,29,21,338/- were booked under WIP during the previous financial year, which were revenue in nature has been transferred to Prior Period Expenses during the current financial year.
- i. Amount of Rs. 5.17 lakh being demand raised by North Delhi Municipal Corporation (North DMC) for short property tax deposited by the University for the year 2018-19 in respect of properties at Dheerpur (₹2.53 lakh), Rohini (₹1.72 lakh) and Karampura Campus (₹0.92 lakh). North DMC stated that 15% rebate on timely payment has been wrongly availed for service charges component of property tax, therefore the above mentioned demand was raised. Accordingly, a provision has been created in this respect during the FY 2021-22.
- j. Preliminary Expenses of Campus Development amounted 13,52,268 was shown as WIP during the previous year, however the same was revenue in nature, accordingly requisite rectification has been posted in FY 2021-22 and expenditure has been transferred to prior period expenses during the current financial year.

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- k. Repair and maintenance, civil and electrical works amounted 1,62,76,784 was booked to WIP in previous year, however the same was revenue in nature, accordingly requisite rectification has been posted in FY 2021-22 and expenditure has been transferred to prior period expenses during the current financial year.

As per Accounting Standard 5, as mentioned above, prior period items include income or expenses that occur in the current period due to errors or omissions while preparing financial statements of one or more prior periods. These do not encompass other adjustments so demanded by situations which are no doubt related to the prior periods but are established in the current period. For instance, arrears outstanding to workers due to revision of wages with retrospective effect during the current period.
