18	Master of Business Administration in Innovation Entrepreneurship and Venture Development	M.B.A. (IEVD)	Applicants need to have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade from a recognised university (Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwBD/ D-OBC(NCL)/Defence/KM).
19	Environment and Development	M.A.	Applicants need to have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline with minimum 45% marks or equivalent grade from a recognised university (Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwBD/ D-OBC (NCL)/Defence/KM).

20	Social Design	M.Des	Applicants need to have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline (3 year) or a 4-year, full time graduate degree/diploma in design from any university or institute recognised by law in India with minimum 45% marks or equivalent grade (Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwBD/D- OBC(NCL)/Defence/KM). Individuals with additional qualifications and work experience are also encouraged to apply. In case the degree/certificate has been obtained from a university/ board of any country other than India, an equivalence certificate must be obtained by the candidate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi, at the time of document verification for seeking admission.
