

## Dr B R Ambedkar Delhi University Library

In furtherance of the Government of NCT Delhi announcement on 31.8.21 on reopening of Universities from 1.9.21, and consequent upon the due approval from the competent authority, the Dr B R Ambedkar University Delhi library will be reopened for physical access in a phased manner, from Monday, September 6, 2021 maintaining the following norms.

The AUD Library shall be opened on all working days (except Holidays) Monday - Friday between 09:00 to 17:30 Hrs. The students can access the Library for issue-return, re-issue and available reading room facilities, by showing their AUD student ID card at any of the three campuses, wherever they find it convenient. Library requests students to wear masks, take alternate seats, use sanitisers and follow all other specific COVID guidelines as per Govt. instructions. If required the Library may restrict entry of students, briefly, depending upon the number of students and library staff already inside the reading room and stack area to maintain distancing norms.

The following will be the roster of students to physically access libraries in each of the three campuses:

### Kashmere Gate Campus

5. Monday and Friday: **SUS** final year students

### Karampura Campus:

1. Wednesday and Thursday: **SLGC** final year PG and UG students
2. Monday and Friday: **SGA** final year PG and UG students
3. Tuesday and Thursday : **SVS** final year UG students

### Lodhi Road campus:

1. Monday and Wednesday: **SES** Phd, MPhil and final year PG students
